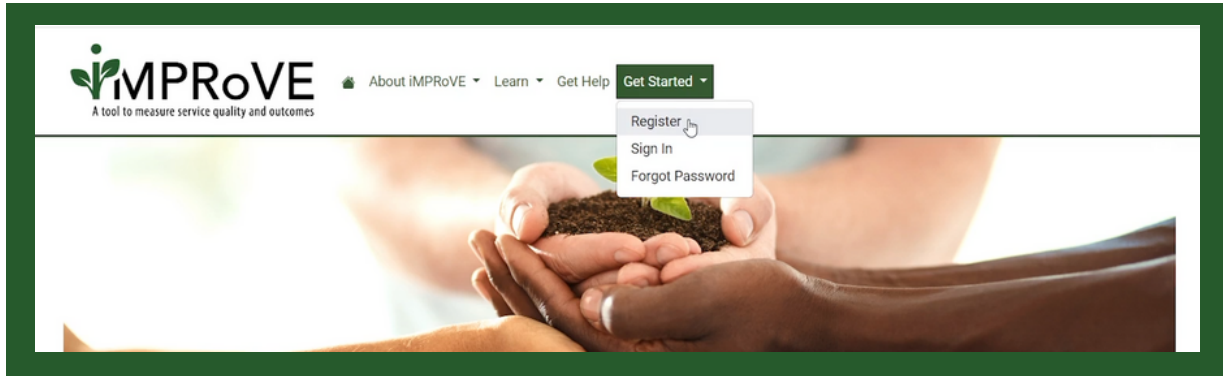

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
1 Go to www.improve-tool.org.

ADMINISTRATOR USES OF AGGREGATE DATA

For the purpose of this agreement, 'aggregate data' refers to Data compiled from persons receiving services and across Providers to show distributions of responses to the iMPRoVE measures. In all uses of aggregate data, the Provider and the persons providing the Data will **not** be identified.

The Administrator will use aggregate data collected through the platform for the purposes specified here. Any other uses must be authorized by Provider, in writing.

- The Administrator may use aggregate Data collected by Providers to display information about victim service outcomes in a publicly available data dashboard that providers could use for benchmarking.
- The Administrator may use Data collected through the platform to produce aggregate reports, presentations, or other data products on the outcomes and quality of victim services for, or as requested by, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime.

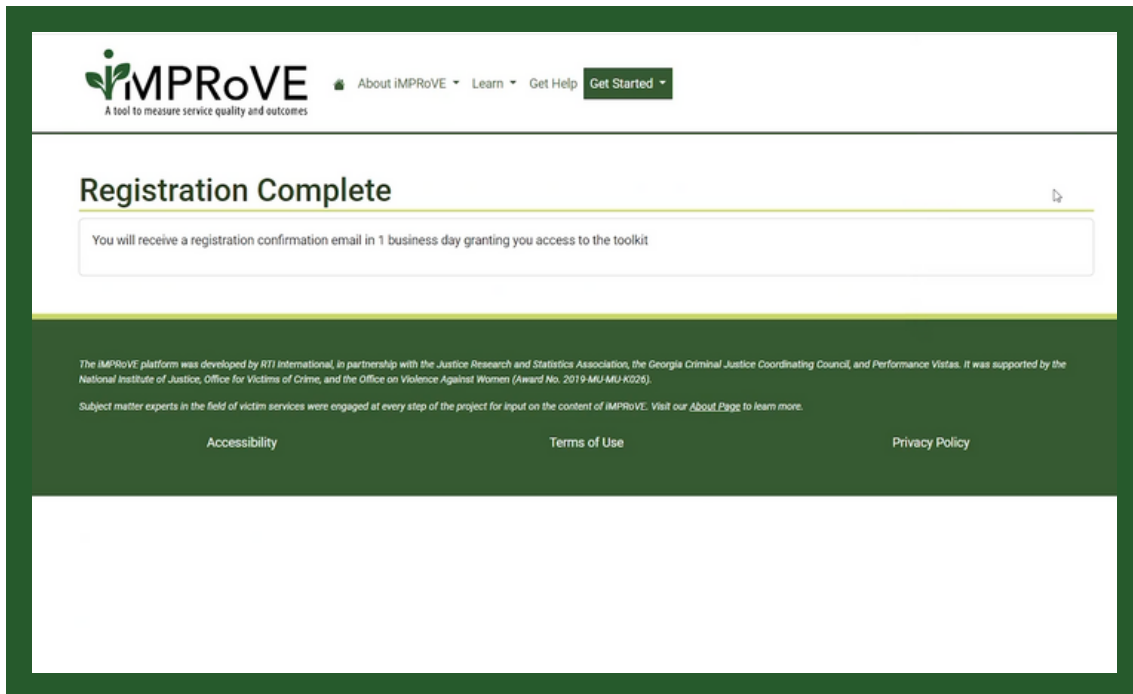
